An article Saturday underreported the number of House members who signed a "protest and dissent" in the House Journal that accused Rep. Arlon Lindner, R-Corcoran, of defaming Jews when he labeled Rep. Michael Paymar, DFL-St. Paul, as "irreligious" during a debate over House prayers. Sixty-four representatives, not 30, signed the protest. Of those, 12 were Republicans. Two Republicans have since removed their names.
