

3 Resolution on Administration of High School Page Program

5 BE IT RESOLVED, by the Committee on Rules and Legislative Administration, that a High  
6 School Page Program administered by the Sergeant-at-Arms must conform to the following  
7 requirements: The maximum number of participants in the program during each year of the  
8 biennial legislative session is 80. If there are no applicants for the program from a house district,  
9 the Sergeant-at-Arms may, at the Sergeant's discretion, select another student. High school  
10 pages serve for a period of one week and receive a stipend of \$10.00 per day. High school pages  
11 who move from their usual place of residence must be reimbursed for actual lodging expenses in  
12 an amount not to exceed \$75.00 per day, except when a higher reimbursement is required due to  
13 the unavailability of a roommate. The Sergeant-at-Arms shall report to the House Budget and  
14 Accounting Office the names of all high school pages. The House of Representatives assumes  
15 no responsibility for supervising high school pages outside of normal working hours, and the  
16 Sergeant-at-Arms shall so inform local school authorities and the parents or guardians of each  
17 high school page.
