

- 1.1 Hortman moves to amend the permanent rules of the House (HPERMRULES2017D)
- 1.2 as follows:
- 1.3 Page 16, after line 31, insert:
- 1.4 "Rule 4.06 JOINT TARGETS.
- 1.5 The House shall comply with joint targets adopted by the Legislative Commission on
- 1.6 Planning and Fiscal Policy. An amendment or a minority report to a bill that has received
- 1.7 its second reading and is being considered by the House is out of order if that amendment
- 1.8 or minority report would violate joint targets adopted pursuant to an action of the
- 1.9 Commission, unless those targets have been modified pursuant to the process under a Joint
- 1.10 Rule. A bill on the General Register already having received its second reading that violates
- 1.11 subsequently adopted joint targets may not be given a third reading unless it has been
- 1.12 amended to conform to joint targets prior to any subsequent action."
