

1.1 Hortman moves to amend Senate Concurrent Resolution No. 4 as follows:

1.2 Page 1, after line 10, insert:

1.3 "Joint Rule 2.065. Joint Targets.

1.4 The House of Representatives and Senate shall comply with joint targets adopted by the
1.5 Legislative Commission on Planning and Fiscal Policy. An amendment or a minority report
1.6 to a bill that has received its second reading and is being considered by the House or Senate
1.7 is out of order if that amendment or minority report would violate joint targets adopted by
1.8 the Commission, unless those targets have been modified by a published statement signed
1.9 by the Speaker of the House and the Majority Leader of the Senate. A bill on the General
1.10 Register already having received its second reading that violates subsequently adopted joint
1.11 targets may not be given a third reading unless it has been amended to conform to joint
1.12 targets prior to any subsequent action.

1.13 Joint Rule 2.08. Joint Targets; Legislative Commission on Planning and Fiscal
1.14 Policy.

1.15 The Legislature shall adopt joint budget targets 14 days prior to the constitutional date
1.16 of adjournment in each annual session. Joint budget targets must:

1.17 (1) be presented to the Legislative Commission on Planning and Fiscal Policy, in a public
1.18 hearing where an opportunity for public testimony is provided;

1.19 (2) establish limits on net expenditures in adequate detail to allow completion of major
1.20 revenue and expenditure bills;

1.21 (3) be adhered to, unless modified via a joint statement of revision signed by the Speaker
1.22 of the House and Majority Leader of the Senate and published by both bodies.

- 2.1 The Legislative Commission on Planning and Fiscal Policy must meet, accept or reject
2.2 amendments to, and approve joint targets under this Rule. If a statement of revision is
2.3 adopted under paragraph (3), the Commission shall meet and hear testimony on that revision."
