Overview

H.F. 3954 modifies how the minimum amount of funding is determined for Head Start programs and adds \$4.5 million to the existing fiscal year 2021 appropriation for the Head Start program.

Summary

Section Description

1 Distribution of appropriation.

Amends § 119A.52. Modifies how the minimum amount of funding is determined for Head Start programs by directing the commissioner of education to assure that each Head Start program in existence in 2020 is allocated no less funding in any fiscal year than it was allocated in fiscal year 2020. Under current law, the commissioner is required to assure that each Head Start program in existence in 1993 is allocated no less funding in any fiscal year than it was allocated in fiscal year 1993.

2 Appropriation.

Adds \$4.5 million to the existing fiscal year 2021 appropriation for the Head Start program. Sets the base for fiscal year 2022 at \$25.1 million.
