

1.1 moves to amend H.F. No. 371 as follows:

1.2 Delete everything after the enacting clause and insert:

1.3 "Section 1. **COVID-19 PEACETIME EMERGENCY; EXECUTIVE ORDER**
1.4 **EXPIRATION.**

1.5 Notwithstanding any law or executive order to the contrary, unless ratified by a majority
1.6 vote of each house of the legislature, executive orders promulgated in response to a peacetime
1.7 emergency declared and extended for the infectious disease known as COVID-19 expire:

1.8 (1) on March 31, 2021, if filed in the Office of the Secretary of State on or before
1.9 February 15, 2021; or

1.10 (2) after 14 days, if filed in the Office of the Secretary of State after February 15, 2021.

1.11 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment and
1.12 applies to executive orders in effect or promulgated on or after that date."

1.13 Delete the title and insert:

1.14 "A bill for an act
1.15 relating to state government; providing that certain COVID-19 executive orders
1.16 expire unless ratified by the legislature."
