1.2 relating to health; establishing requirements for certain health care entity  
1.3 transactions; changing the expiration date on moratorium conversion transactions;  
1.4 requiring a health system to return charitable assets received from the state to the  
1.5 general fund in certain circumstances; requiring a study on the regulation of certain  
1.6 transactions; requiring a report; appropriating money; amending Minnesota Statutes  
1.7 2022, section 62U.04, subdivision 11; Laws 2017, First Special Session chapter  
1.8 6, article 5, section 11, as amended; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota  
1.9 Statutes, chapter 309; proposing coding for new law as Minnesota Statutes, chapter  
1.10 145D.

1.11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.12 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 62U.04, subdivision 11, is amended to read:

1.13 Subd. 11. **Restricted uses of the all-payer claims data.** (a) Notwithstanding subdivision  
1.14 4, paragraph (b), and subdivision 5, paragraph (b), the commissioner or the commissioner's  
1.15 designee shall only use the data submitted under subdivisions 4 and 5 for the following  
1.16 purposes:

1.17 (1) to evaluate the performance of the health care home program as authorized under  
1.18 section 62U.03, subdivision 7;

1.19 (2) to study, in collaboration with the reducing avoidable readmissions effectively

1.1 Long from the Committee on Rules and Legislative Administration to which was referred:

1.2 H. F. No. 2, A bill for an act relating to employment; creating a family and medical  
1.3 benefit insurance program; requiring leave from employment under certain circumstances;  
1.4 allowing substitution of a private plan; prohibiting retaliation; classifying data; authorizing  
1.5 expedited rulemaking; appropriating money; amending Minnesota Statutes 2022, sections  
1.6 13.719, by adding a subdivision; 62A.01, subdivision 1; 177.27, subdivision 4; 181.032;  
1.7 256B.0659, subdivision 18; 256B.85, subdivisions 13, 13a; 256J.561, by adding a  
1.8 subdivision; 256J.95, subdivisions 3, 11; 256P.01, subdivision 3; 268.19, subdivision 1;  
1.9 proposing coding for new law as Minnesota Statutes, chapter 268B.

1.10 Reported the same back with the recommendation that the bill be re-referred to the  
1.11 Committee on Workforce Development Finance and Policy.

1.12 Joint Rule 2.03 has been waived for any subsequent committee action on this bill.
