1.2 H. F. No. 3276, A bill for an act relating to elections; providing for ranked choice voting;
1.3 authorizing jurisdictions to adopt ranked choice voting for local offices; establishing
1.4 procedures for adoption, implementation, and use of ranked choice voting for local
1.5 jurisdictions; allowing local jurisdictions to use electronic voting systems with a reallocation
1.6 feature; authorizing rulemaking; amending Minnesota Statutes 2022, sections 204B.35,
1.7 subdivision 1; 204C.21, by adding a subdivision; 204D.07, subdivision 3; 205.13, subdivision
1.8 2; 206.57, by adding a subdivision; Minnesota Statutes 2023 Supplement, section 206.83;
1.9 proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 206; proposing coding for
1.10 new law as Minnesota Statutes, chapter 204E.
