Grace Schwabb, from the Minnesota School Board Association testified against the bill.

Sen. Bachmann moved an oral amendment to SF180 as follows: Delete lines 9 to 11, line 12 delete everything before the period. Insert, "A parent or guardian of twins or higher order multiples may request that the children be placed in the same classroom or in separate classrooms if their children are in the same grade level at the same school. A school must provide the placement requested by the parent or guardian.

The motion prevailed.

Sen. Bachmann moved SF 180 be passed to the floor as amended. The motion prevailed.

Sen. Wiger introduced SF 419.

Marilyn Leifgren, School Psychologist, Student Services Coalition, testified in support of SF 419.

Sen. Skoe moved SF 419 to be passed to the floor. The motion prevailed.

The committee then heard testimony concerning bioscience education.
