Eric Nauman - fiscal analyst - reviewed the general levy under current law and under the governor's recommendation. Nauman also presented a spreadsheet of new K-12 levies per pupil in each school district.

Jack Paulson - senate counsel - discussed the effect increased levies would have on property taxes. He said on average, statewide, there would be a 2 or 3 percent increase. In all, under the governor's proposal there would be about a \$190 million increase.
