

1 Senator moves to amend S.F. No. 1278 as
2 follows:

3 Page 61, line 17, after the comma, insert "excluding any
4 amount disallowed by reverse referendum,"

5 Page 61, line 18, after "year" insert ", excluding any
6 amount disallowed by reverse referendum,"

7 Page 61, line 23, delete "September 30" and insert "October
8 10"

9 Page 62, after line 3, insert:

10 "(d) The ballot must state the revenue categories that the
11 board proposes to increase, the maximum amount of the increased
12 revenue per pupil, and the estimated tax rate as a percentage of
13 net tax capacity in the first year it is to be levied. The
14 ballot shall contain a textual portion with the information
15 required in this paragraph and a question stating substantially
16 the following: "Shall the increase in revenue proposed by the
17 board of, School District No. ..., be approved?"

18 (e) The sum of a district's final discretionary revenue,
19 special education levy revenue, and deferred maintenance revenue
20 per pupil unit for a fiscal year must not exceed the sum of the
21 amounts certified by the district according to paragraph (a). A
22 district may elect to reduce the amount certified according to
23 paragraph (a) at the time of final levy certification. If the
24 criteria for a reverse referendum have been met, but the amount
25 certified is reduced to a level that would not require a reverse
26 referendum, the county auditor must cancel the reverse
27 referendum."
