"The maximum annual budget to implement section 248.062 may not exceed \$100,000." Page 3, after line 3, insert

Sec 5 [Effective Date] Section 1 to 4 are effective the day following final enactment and applies to the budget for section 248.062 for services provided after April 15, 2005. The motion prevailed.

Sen. Gaither moved SF 1064, as amended, be recommended to pass and be re-referred to the full committee on Jobs.
