Sen. Murphy called the meeting to order at 3:10 pm.

Sen. Wiger brought forward S.F. 365. Sen. Day offered the A-8 amendment. Sen. Wiger spoke in opposition to the amendment. Sen. Day asked for a roll call on the amendment. Sen. Day offered an oral amendment to his A-8 amendment (lines 9 and 11, strike "\$418,000" and insert "\$209,000"). Sen. Day withdrew his oral amendment. A roll call vote was taken on the A-8 amendment:

NAYS (8): Murphy, Chaudhary, Dibble, Langseth, Marko, Moua, Vickerman, Wiger

The amendment failed on a 6 to 8 vote. Sen. Wiger moved that the bill be passed and sent to Finance. The motion passed on a voice vote.

Sen. Belanger and Sen. Michel came before the Committee to discuss S.F. 75 (Belanger) and S.F. 236 (Michel). Handout A was distributed. Sen. Moua moved the A-2 amendment to S.F. 75. The amendment passed on a voice vote. Betsy Parker from Mn/DOT; Ron Osterbauer, Bridging, Inc., 201 W 87th St, Bloomington, MN; Howard Marcus, Minnesota Transportation Services Association, 840 Hampdon Ave, St. Paul, MN; and Dave Bailey, Two Men and a

Truck Moving, 14217 Ewing Ave., Burnsville, MN, testified in support of S.F. 75. John Gendreau, Two Men and a Truck Moving, 14500 Martin Drive, Eden Prairie, MN, testified in support of S.F. 236. Sen. Murphy moved the A-1 amendment to S.F. 236, which passed on a voice vote. Sen. Moua moved that S.F. 75 be passed and sent to the consent calendar. The motion prevailed on voice vote. The committee took no action on S.F. 236.




Sen. Moua took the chair at 4:14.
