Sen. Murphy called the meeting to order at 3:08 pm.

Sen. Murphy presented S.F. 1193. Handout A was distributed. Sen. Day moved adoption of the Subcommittee Report. The motion passed on a voice vote. Lee Henderson, representing Interstate Companies, 2601 E 80th St, Bloomington, MN 55425, testified in support of the bill. Mike Louis, from the Aeronautics Division of Mn/DOT, answered committee member's questions.



On a vote of 11-5, Sen. Murphy's motion prevailed.

Sen. Murphy presented S.F. 1794. Sen. Johnson moved that the bill be recommended to pass and sent to the Committee on Commerce. Pat McCormack, Director of Driver and Vehicle Services at DPS, testified in support of the bill. Bob Johnson, Insurance Federation of Minnesota, 401 Robert St N, Suite #208, St. Paul, MN, testified that he would work with Sen. Murphy to work out their differences in the commerce committee. Sen. Murphy offered the A-1 amendment, which passed on a voice vote. Sen. Johnson renewed his motion to send the bill to the commerce committee. The motion prevailed on a voice vote.

Sen. Murphy then presented S.F. XXX, which would become the Senate's Transportation Omnibus Finance bill. Amy Vennewitz, Senate Fiscal Analyst, and Bonnie Berezovsky, Senate Counsel, discussed various sections of the bill. No action was taken.

Sen. Murphy adjourned the meeting at 6:12 pm.
