
Senator LeRoy A. Stumpf called the meeting to order at 9:55 a.m.

Discussion of K-12 Supplemental Education Budget bill

Senator Kelley, chief author of S.F. 2994 offered the A-33 amendment which removes substantive policy provisions and non-technical finance provisions. Kelley explained that the intention was to move the bill forward with primarily technical and nearly universally agreed upon policy language, with only a few technical finance provisions. **MOTION CARRIED.**

This language will also appear in the omnibus K-12 budget bill, along with the substantive provisions.
