

Senators Kelley, Clark, Skoglund, Foley and Dibble introduced—

S.F. No. 2912: Referred to the Committee on Education.

A bill for an act
relating to education finance; reducing elementary and secondary class sizes
through a voluntary, incentive-based funding program; appropriating money;
amending Minnesota Statutes 2004, sections 120B.36, subdivision 1; 126C.20;
proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 126C; repealing
Minnesota Statutes 2004, section 126C.12.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2004, section 120B.36, subdivision 1, is amended to read:

Subdivision 1. **School performance report cards.** (a) The commissioner shall
use objective criteria based on levels of student performance to identify four to six
designations applicable to high and low performing public schools. The objective criteria
shall include at least student academic performance, school safety, student-to-teacher
ratios, and staff characteristics, with a value-added growth component added by the
2006-2007 school year.

(b) The commissioner shall develop, annually update, and post on the department
Web site school performance report cards. A school's designation must be clearly stated
on each school performance report card.

(c) The commissioner must make available the first school designations and school
performance report cards by November 2003, and during the beginning of each school
year thereafter.

(d) A school or district may appeal in writing a designation under this section to the
commissioner within 30 days of receiving the designation. The commissioner's decision
to uphold or deny an appeal is final.

(e) School performance report cards are nonpublic data under section 13.02,
subdivision 9, until not later than ten days after the appeal procedure described in

2.1 paragraph (d) concludes. The department shall annually post school performance report
2.2 cards to its public Web site no later than September 1.

2.3 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective for report cards issued after July
2.4 1, 2006.

2.5 **Sec. 2. [126C.105] CLASS SIZE REDUCTION PROGRAM.**

2.6 Subdivision 1. Definition. "Classroom teacher" means a public employee
2.7 licensed by the Board of Teaching who is authorized to teach all subjects to children
2.8 in any grade in kindergarten through grade 12 and whose duties are full-time regular
2.9 classroom instruction, excluding a teacher for whom federal aids are received or for
2.10 whom categorical aids are received under section 125A.76 or who is an itinerant teacher
2.11 or provides instruction outside of the regular classroom. Except as provided in section
2.12 122A.68, subdivision 6, classroom teacher does not include supervisory and support
2.13 personnel defined in section 122A.15.

2.14 Subd. 2. Full funding eligibility. To qualify for funding under this section, a
2.15 school district shall maintain in each participating class an annual average class size not
2.16 exceeding the ratios established in subdivision 3 during the instructional time qualifying
2.17 the class for funding.

2.18 Subd. 3. Class size ratios. The class size ratios are as follows:

2.19 (1) for students in kindergarten to grade 3, a school district shall maintain a ratio
2.20 of not more than 20 students for each classroom teacher;

2.21 (2) for students in grades 4 to 6, a school district shall maintain a ratio of not more
2.22 than 22 students for each classroom teacher;

2.23 (3) for students in grades 7 to 9 in English, mathematics, science, and social studies
2.24 classes, a school district shall maintain a ratio of not more than 25 students for each
2.25 classroom teacher;

2.26 (4) for students in grades 10 to 12 in English, mathematics, science, and social
2.27 studies classes, a school district shall maintain a ratio of not more than 28 students for
2.28 each classroom teacher; and

2.29 (5) for students in grades 7 to 12, in classrooms that are designated as laboratory
2.30 classrooms, a school district shall maintain a ratio of not more than 24 students for each
2.31 classroom teacher.

2.32 Subd. 4. Class size determination. A school district's class size may exceed the
2.33 class size ratios established in subdivision 3 on a particular school day, but the average
2.34 class size for the school year must not exceed the maximum class size.

3.1 Subd. 5. Revenue. A school district that certifies to the Department of Education
3.2 that it is eligible for full funding under subdivision 2 is eligible for class size reduction
3.3 revenue of \$500 times the number of elementary students in each qualifying classroom in
3.4 kindergarten through grade 6, and \$100 times the number of secondary students.

3.5 Subd. 6. Use of revenue. Revenue received through the class size reduction
3.6 program at the secondary level shall be used to maintain the ratios specified in subdivision
3.7 3, clauses (3) and (4), for English, mathematics, science, and social studies classrooms.

3.8 Subd. 7. State aid. Class size reduction revenue is provided entirely through
3.9 state aid.

3.10 EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective for revenue for fiscal years 2007
3.11 and later.

3 Sec. 3. Minnesota Statutes 2004, section 126C.20, is amended to read:

3.13 **126C.20 ANNUAL GENERAL EDUCATION AID APPROPRIATION.**

3.14 There is annually appropriated from the general fund to the department the amount
3.15 necessary for general education aid and class size reduction aid under section 126C.105.
3.16 This amount must be reduced by the amount of any money specifically appropriated for
3.17 the same purpose in any year from any state fund.

3.18 EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective for revenue for fiscal year 2007.

3.19 Sec. 4. APPROPRIATION.

3.20 \$300,000,000 in fiscal year 2007 is appropriated from the general fund to the
3.21 commissioner of education for class size reduction revenue according to section 2.

3.22 Sec. 5. REPEALER.

3.23 Minnesota Statutes 2004, section 126C.12, is repealed.

APPENDIX
Repealed Minnesota Statutes: 06-6197

126C.12 LEARNING AND DEVELOPMENT REVENUE AMOUNT AND USE.

Subdivision 1. Revenue. Of a district's general education revenue for fiscal year 2000 and thereafter each school district shall reserve an amount equal to the formula allowance multiplied by the following calculation:

- (1) the sum of adjusted marginal cost pupils in average daily membership, according to section 126C.05, subdivision 5, in kindergarten times .057; plus
- (2) the sum of adjusted marginal cost pupils in average daily membership, according to section 126C.05, subdivision 5, in grades 1 to 3 times .115; plus
- (3) the sum of adjusted marginal cost pupils in average daily membership, according to section 126C.05, subdivision 5, in grades 4 to 6 times .06.

Subd. 2. Definitions. (a) "Classroom teacher" means a public employee licensed by the board of teaching who is authorized to teach all subjects to children in any grade in kindergarten through grade 6 and whose duties are full-time regular classroom instruction, excluding a teacher for whom federal aids are received or for whom categorical aids are received under section 125A.76 or who is an itinerant teacher or provides instruction outside of the regular classroom. Except as provided in section 122A.68, subdivision 6, classroom teacher does not include supervisory and support personnel defined in section 122A.15. A classroom teacher whose duties are less than full-time instruction must be included as an equivalent only for the number of hours of instruction in kindergarten through grade 3.

(b) "Class size" means the districtwide ratio at each grade level of the number of full-time students in kindergarten through grade 3 served at least 40 percent of the time in regular classrooms to the number of full-time classroom teachers in kindergarten through grade 3, determined as of October 1 of each school year.

Subd. 3. Instruction contact time. Instruction may be provided by a classroom teacher or by a team of classroom teachers, or by a teacher resident supervised by a classroom teacher. The district must maximize classroom teacher to learner average instructional contact time in the core subjects of reading and mathematics.

Subd. 4. Revenue use. (a) Revenue must be used to reduce and maintain the district's average class size in kindergarten through grade 3 to a level of 17 to 1 on average in each of the respective grades.

(b) A district must not increase the districtwide class sizes in other grades as a result of reducing class sizes in kindergarten through grade 3. Revenue may not be used to provide instructor preparation. A district may use a portion of the revenue reserved under this section to employ up to the same number of full-time equivalent education assistants or aides as the district employed during the 1992-1993 school year under Minnesota Statutes 1992, section 124.331, subdivision 2, through fiscal year 2002. Beginning in fiscal year 2003, class size reduction revenue may only be reserved to employ classroom teachers contributing to lower class sizes in kindergarten through grade 3.

Subd. 5. Additional revenue use. If the board of a district determines that the district has achieved and is maintaining the class sizes specified in subdivision 4, the board may use the revenue to reduce class size in grades 4, 5, and 6, provide all-day, everyday kindergarten, prepare and use individualized learning plans, improve program offerings, purchase instructional material, services, or technology, or provide staff development needed for reduced class sizes.

Subd. 6. Annual report. By December 1 of each year, districts receiving revenue under subdivision 1 shall make available to the public a report on the amount of revenue the district has received and the use of the revenue. This report shall be in the form and manner determined by the commissioner and shall include the district average class sizes in kindergarten through grade 6 as of October 1 of the current school year and the class sizes for each site serving kindergarten through grade 6 students in the district. A copy of the report shall be filed with the commissioner by December 15.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2005 Supplement, section 126C.10, subdivision 31,
1.7 is amended to read:

1.8 Subd. 31. **Transition revenue.** (a) A district's transition allowance equals the
1.9 greater of zero or the product of the ratio of the number of adjusted marginal cost pupil
1.10 units the district would have counted for fiscal year 2004 under Minnesota Statutes 2002
1.11 to the district's adjusted marginal cost pupil units for fiscal year 2004, times the difference
between: (1) the lesser of the district's general education revenue per adjusted marginal
1.13 cost pupil unit for fiscal year 2003 or the amount of general education revenue the district
1.14 would have received per adjusted marginal cost pupil unit for fiscal year 2004 according
1.15 to Minnesota Statutes 2002, and (2) the district's general education revenue for fiscal year
1.16 2004 excluding transition revenue divided by the number of adjusted marginal cost pupil
1.17 units the district would have counted for fiscal year 2004 under Minnesota Statutes 2002.

1.18 (b) A district's transition revenue for fiscal year 2006 and later equals the sum of (1)
1.19 the product of the district's transition allowance times the district's adjusted marginal cost
1.20 pupil units plus (2) the amount of referendum revenue under section 126C.17 and general
1.21 education revenue, excluding transition revenue, for fiscal year 2004 attributable to pupils
1.22 four or five years of age on September 1, 2003, enrolled in a prekindergarten program
1.23 implemented by the district before July 1, 2003, and reported as kindergarten pupils under
1.24 section 126C.05, subdivision 1, for fiscal year 2004, plus (3) the amount of compensatory

2.1 education revenue under subdivision 3 for fiscal year 2005 attributable to pupils four years
2.2 of age on September 1, 2003, enrolled in a prekindergarten program implemented by the
2.3 district before July 1, 2003, and reported as kindergarten pupils under section 126C.05,
2.4 subdivision 1, for fiscal year 2004 multiplied by .04.

2.5 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective for revenue for fiscal year 2007.

A bill for an act

relating to education finance; increasing equity revenue for districts above the 95th percentile; amending Minnesota Statutes 2005 Supplement, section 126C.10, subdivision 24.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2005 Supplement, section 126C.10, subdivision 24, is amended to read:

Subd. 24. Equity revenue. (a) A school district qualifies for equity revenue if:

(1) the school district's adjusted marginal cost pupil unit amount of basic revenue, supplemental revenue, transition revenue, and referendum revenue is less than the value of the school district at or immediately above the 95th percentile of school districts in its equity region for those revenue categories; and

(2) the school district's administrative offices are not located in a city of the first class on July 1, 1999.

(b) Equity revenue for a qualifying district that receives referendum revenue under section 126C.17, subdivision 4, equals the product of (1) the district's adjusted marginal cost pupil units for that year; times (2) the sum of (i) \$13, plus (ii) \$75, times the school district's equity index computed under subdivision 27.

(c) Equity revenue for a qualifying district that does not receive referendum revenue under section 126C.17, subdivision 4, equals the product of the district's adjusted marginal cost pupil units for that year times \$13.

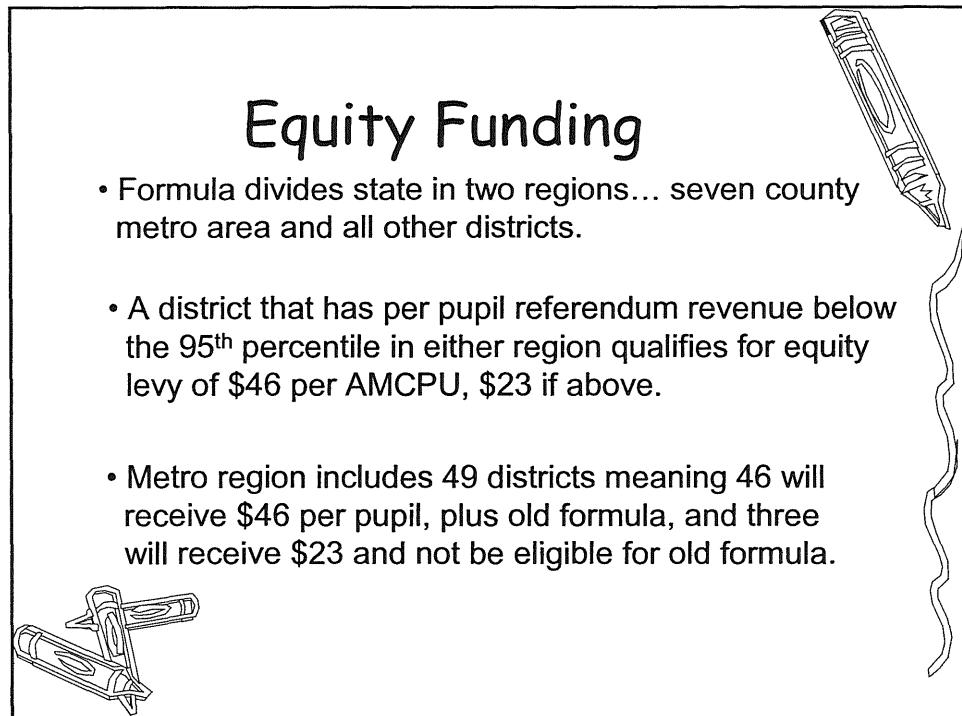
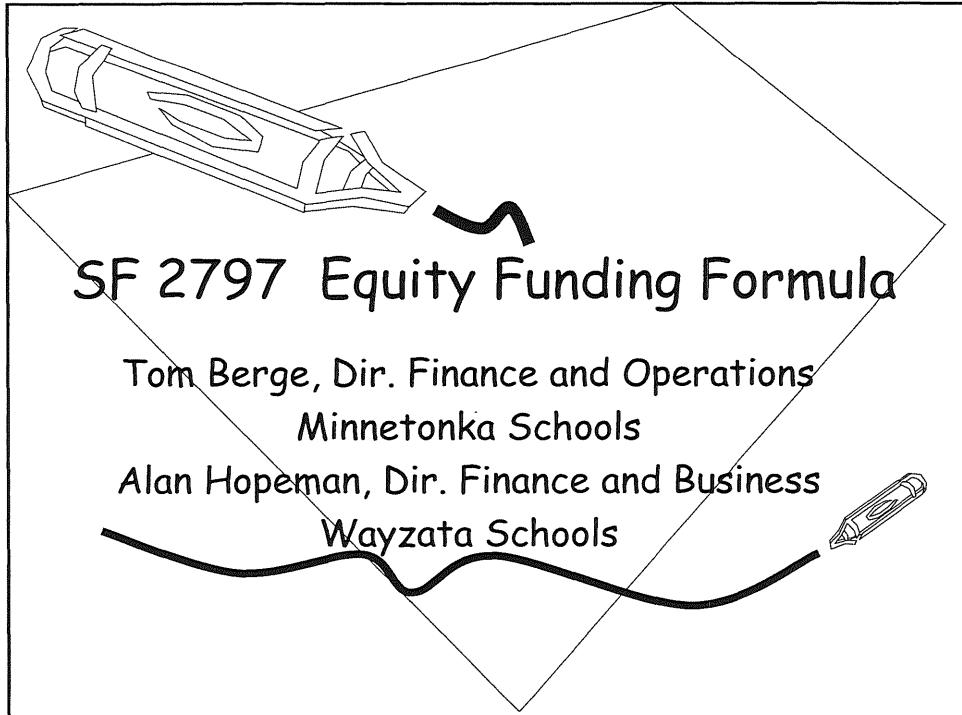
(d) A school district's equity revenue is increased by the greater of zero or an amount equal to the district's resident marginal pupil units times the difference between ten percent of the statewide average amount of referendum revenue per resident marginal

2.1 cost pupil unit for that year and the district's referendum revenue per resident marginal
2.2 cost pupil unit. A school district's revenue under this paragraph must not exceed \$100,000
2.3 for that year.

2.4 (e) A school district's equity revenue for a school district located in the metro equity
2.5 region equals the amount computed in paragraphs (b), (c), and (d) multiplied by 1.25.

2.6 (f) For fiscal year 2007 and later, notwithstanding paragraph (a), clause (2), a school

Why is Equity Funding Important?

A comparison of spending, using School Profiles data, provides an informative backdrop as to why this issue is very important to Minnetonka and Wayzata Schools.

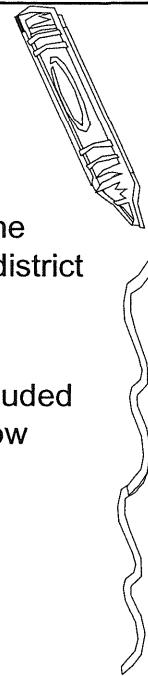
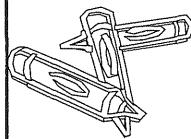

Equity Formula Excessively Complicated

- For districts at or near the 95th percentile eligibility for the equity levy is very uncertain. Small changes in base data result in large swings in revenue.
- Eligibility is based on referendum revenue per AMCPU (Adjusted marginal cost pupil unit).
- Problem: The 2006 levy authorization is based upon variables which will not be finalized until 2008.

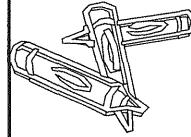
Creates Budget Uncertainty

- Minnetonka and Wayzata are essentially tied for the 95th percentile and will not know until 2008 which district will keep the money in the 2006 levy.
- To assure access to the revenue both districts included the full equity revenue authorized for a district below the 95th percentile in the 2006 levy.



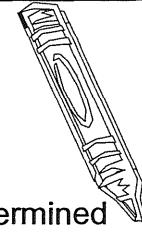
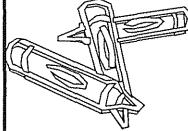
Predicting Eligibility Uncertain

- If all variables remain constant for the next two years Minnetonka will be at the 95th percentile and will incur a significant levy and budget adjustment.
- And Wayzata would be below the 95th percentile and would retain its 2006 equity levy.
- However, if there is one thing certain, the variables used in 2005 for the 2006 levy will change by 2008.



Funding Cliff at 95th Percentile

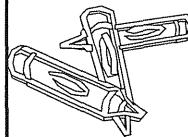
- A “funding cliff” has been created and will be determined by the following variables outside the control of either district:
 - Total enrollment including open enrollment.
 - Resident enrollment.
 - Rate of inflation.
- A change in one of the variables would change per pupil referendum revenue, and therefore could change eligibility for the equity levy.

Funding Cliff at 95th Percentile

- Final calculation for 06-07 will occur in 2008 with any adjustment to the 2006 levy made on the 2009 levy for the 2009-2010 fiscal year.
- A missed estimate now could be repeated two to three years before it is known and adjusted.
- Creates extensive budget uncertainty at the local level and could create significant financial problems for either district in 2009 when the variables are finalized.

Summary

- Current equity formula creates significant budget uncertainty at the local district level.
Any levy correction will occur three years from now.
- Does not impact state aid, only property taxes.
- Minnetonka and Wayzata not high spending districts - not even ranked in top 1/3 in state.
- Spending (revenue) increase since 97-98 have been two-thirds of state average.

Equity Funding

Solution:

Adopt SF 2797... Eliminate the cliff at the 95% level.
Place all districts on an equal footing.

Bill Description

The bill extends the additional \$46 per pupil in equity revenue to all school districts. Under current law, districts with per pupil referendum revenue below the 95th percentile receive an additional \$46 per pupil in equity revenue, while districts at or above the 95th percentile receive half that amount or \$23 per pupil. The additional equity revenue is a new component and was scheduled to begin in FY 2007. This change would also be effective beginning FY 2007.

Assumptions

- School districts with referendums in place for FY 2007 would continue with the authority for FY 2008 and 2009.
- Estimates of pupils and referendum market value based on February Forecast data.
- 14 districts are at or above the 95th percentile based on the projected data.
- Since this provision would increase the statewide average equity revenue per pupil, charter school equity aid would also increase by a modest amount.

1.12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.13 Section 1. **[124D.33] EARLY CHILDHOOD LEARNING PREPAREDNESS AND**
1.14 **ENRICHMENT ALLOWANCE.**

1.15 Subdivision 1. **Allowance; purpose.** An early childhood learning preparedness and
1.16 enrichment allowance program is established, which will provide an allowance to families
1.17 of young children, to be used for learning preparedness and to enrich, enhance, improve,
1.18 or benefit the child's physical, educational, artistic, or musical development.

1.19 Subd. 2. **Eligibility; allowance amount.** A claimant with a child who is at least
1.20 six months old through age five on April 15 of the year when the allowance is claimed is
1.21 eligible to receive an allowance of \$200 for each eligible child. In addition, the allowance
1.22 for each eligible child must be increased according to the following:

2.13 As used in this section, "family income" is equal to "income" as defined in
 2.14 Minnesota Statutes, section 290.067, subdivision 2a, for the taxable year preceding the
 2.15 calendar year when the allowance is claimed, and "claimant" means an individual who
 2.16 meets the requirements of section 152 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended
 2.17 through December 31, 2005, to claim the eligible child as a dependent.

2.18 Subd. 3. Commissioner of revenue duties; determining eligible claimants;
 2.19 payment of the allowance. (a) The commissioner of revenue shall include on the
 2.20 individual income tax form the information that is necessary to determine claimants who
 2.21 are eligible to receive an allowance, and must develop a method to locate potential
 2.22 claimants who do not file state income tax forms and inform them of the availability of
 2.23 the allowance.

2.24 (b) The commissioner of revenue shall establish a process to transfer the allowance
 2.25 to claimants electronically.

2.26 (c) Claims for the allowance must be submitted by April 15. The commissioner of
 2.27 revenue must certify the allowance no later than August 15 of the year when the claim is
 2.28 submitted.

2.29 Subd. 4. Commissioner of education duties. (a) The commissioner shall, after
 2.30 consultation with stakeholders and professionals:

 2.33 (3) establish minimum administrative and service guidelines and standards for

3.1 (5) develop a process to review program categories recommended by local early

3.4 (6) develop a process for payments to providers based on the allowances.

3.5 (b) The commissioner is granted rulemaking authority as necessary to carry out the
3.6 duties in paragraph (a).

3.7 **Subd. 5. Local early childhood board composition and duties.** (a) "Local early
3.8 childhood board" means the group composed of one member of the following groups, if
3.9 they exist in the school district:

3.10 (1) other early childhood education-related boards;

3.11 (2) three parents of children age five or under who represent the economic and
3.12 ethnic diversity of the community;

3.14 (3) licensed child care providers;

3.15 (4) early childhood education providers;

3.16 (5) a representative from a program that provides physical education opportunities to
children;

3.17 (6) school superintendents' designee;

3.18 (7) public or private nonprofit agencies serving youth and families;

3.19 (8) an individual or a representative from a program that provides musical instruction
3.20 or classes to children;

3.21 (9) a representative from the arts community;

3.22 (10) local child care resource and referral programs; and

3.23 (11) the county board of commissioners.

3.24 (b) A local early childhood board must:

3.25 (1) assess the community's current capacity to address the early childhood learning
3.26 preparedness and enrichment needs of children from six months to kindergarten entrance;

3.27 (2) create and implement a method to qualify early childhood program learning
3.28 preparedness and categories in the community, according to the criteria under subdivision
3.29 7;

3.30 (3) qualify program categories that aim to meet early childhood learning
3.31 preparedness and enrichment needs;

3.32 (4) create an ongoing evaluation of program categories in relation to outcomes
3.33 for children and families;

3.34 (5) provide an appropriate public forum in the community to evaluate whether
3.35 a program category continues to meet community expectations and the criteria under
3.36 subdivision 7; and

4.1 (6) develop procedures to restrict allowance payments only to providers that meet
4.2 community expectations and the criteria under subdivision 7.

4.3 **Subd. 6. Local school boards; charter school boards; nonpublic school boards.**
4.4 School boards in the school district, including boards from the public school system,
4.5 charter schools, and nonpublic schools, may provide comments and recommendations
4.6 to the local early childhood board, with regard to the board's duties under subdivision 5,
4.7 paragraph (b), clauses (2), (3), and (4). The commissioner of education makes the final
4.8 program category determination under subdivision 4, paragraph (a), clause (5).

4.9 **Subd. 7. General criteria for activities.** The early childhood allowance must be
4.10 used during the 12 months following receipt of the allowance by the claimant for a child
4.11 who is at least six months old through age five, to pay for qualified learning preparedness
4.12 activities, or programs or classes that enrich, improve, or benefit the child's physical,
4.13 educational, artistic, or musical development. The allowance may not be used for base
4.14 child care costs or expenses.

4.15 **Subd. 8. Allowance is not income for purposes of other publicly funded**
4.16 programs. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the allowance does not count as
4.17 earned income for purposes of the medical assistance, MinnesotaCare, MFIP, or child
4.18 care assistance programs.
