
### **HEAPR** methodology

# 135A.046 - Asset Preservation and Replacement Uses:

- Code compliance, health and safety
- Energy efficiency improvements
- Preserve interior and exterior of existing buildings
- Renewal to support existing mission
- Design for future projects

### **HEAPR Scope:**

- 30 colleges and 7 universities
- 54 campuses
- 22.5 millions square feet
- 843 academic buildings

### **Assessing needs**

#### **Comprehensive Facilities Plans**

- Current and forecast academic programs
- Facilities conditions and configuration
- Priorities and avenues
- 5-year cycle

#### **Facility condition reviews**


- Systems approach
- Annually

#### **Management tool: VFA Facility**

- Input: building age, type, conditions, etc.
- Data integration, modeling, and reports

### Avenues for meeting needs

#### Campus funding – R&R

Goal: \$1 per square foot ~ \$22 million annually

- Major capital projects
- HEAPR appropriations



**Total program: \$292.9 million** 

**Asset preservation - HEAPR:** 

- \$150.0 million
- 70 projects statewide

#### **Major projects:**

- \$142.9 million
- 20 major capital projects
  - 4 Construction of previously funded design
  - 6 Design and construction
  - 10 Design for future construction

#### **2022 Program financing:**

- State: \$245.3 million
- User: \$47.6 million
