2022 REVISOR'S BILL SUMMARY

ARTICLE 1

This article corrects technical errors generally, in statutes and laws. It corrects erroneous, obsolete or incomplete cross references and internal references, either by striking references to repealed or invalid provisions or, as applicable, supplying the correct, updated, or complete citation. Occasionally, the reference to a repealed provision of statute is still appropriate, but a reference to the last edition of the statutes in which the section appeared is added to the reference. Typographical, grammatical, or corrections for style and form are made. Miscellaneous drafting errors and omissions are corrected. Obsolete language is removed or, as applicable, replaced and terminology is updated or similar conforming changes are made. Expired or obsolete provisions are repealed.

ARTICLE 2

This article makes technical changes and reorganizes definitions in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 327C, Manufactured Home Park Lot Rentals.

ARTICLE 3

This article makes grammatical changes to Minnesota Statutes, chapter 462A, Minnesota Housing Finance Agency.

ARTICLE 4

This article updates references in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 13, to data practice provisions codified outside of chapter 13.
