

1.1 **Senator Mathews from the Committee on Civil Law and Data Practices Policy, to**  
1.2 **which was re-referred**

1.3 **S.F. No. 182:** A bill for an act relating to human services; requiring destruction of certain  
1.4 welfare data.

1.5 Reports the same back with the recommendation that the bill be amended as follows:

1.6 Page 1, line 6, before "Notwithstanding" insert "(a)" and after the second comma, insert  
1.7 "ten years following the date the data was collected or created,"

1.8 Page 1, line 9, delete "welfare data" and insert "nonlong-term services and supports  
1.9 claims data that is not needed to comply with active litigation, fraud prevention or  
1.10 investigation, or third party liability requirements,"

1.11 Page 1, after line 17, insert:

1.12 "(b) The commissioner of human services, in collaboration with any other responsible  
1.13 authority identified in paragraph (a), shall submit a report to the chairs and ranking minority  
1.14 members of the legislative committees with jurisdiction over data practices and human  
1.15 services by January 15, 2027, confirming compliance with this section.

1.16 (c) The responsible authority must comply with paragraph (a) within a reasonable period  
1.17 not to exceed 60 days following the expiration of the ten year retention period identified in  
1.18 paragraph (a)."

1.19 And when so amended the bill do pass and be re-referred to the Committee on Health  
1.20 and Human Services Finance and Policy. Amendments adopted. Report adopted.
