

1.1 Senator moves to amend S.F. No. 3087 as follows:

1.2 Page 3, after line 16, insert:

1.3 "Sec. 4. **5B.14 PROGRAM AUDIT.**

1.4 (a) The legislative auditor shall conduct an audit of the program established under this
1.5 chapter and all program participants to ensure compliance with this chapter, chapter 203B,
1.6 and any other applicable law. The legislative auditor shall complete the first audit by August
1.7 1, 2022, and biennially thereafter. The legislative auditor shall submit a report to the chairs
1.8 and ranking minority members of the committees in the senate and the house of
1.9 representatives with jurisdiction over the secretary of state's office and data practices by
1.10 January 15, 2023, and biennially thereafter.

1.11 (b) The legislative auditor shall have access to all data necessary to complete an audit
1.12 under this section, including not public data as defined in section 13.02, subdivision 8a.
1.13 Upon release of a final audit report by the legislative auditor, data relating to an audit are
1.14 public except data otherwise classified as not public.

1.15 (c) If the legislative auditor determines that data maintained as part of the program is
1.16 inaccurate or noncompliant with current law, the legislative auditor must provide that
1.17 information to the secretary of state. Within 60 days of receiving the information from the
1.18 legislative auditor, the secretary of state must delete or otherwise correct the data and provide
1.19 verification to the legislative auditor that the data has been deleted or corrected. The
1.20 legislative auditor must include the secretary of state's verification in its report to the
1.21 legislature under paragraph (a)."

1.22 Page 8, after line 10, insert:

1.23 "Sec. 9. **APPROPRIATION; SAFE AT HOME AUDIT.**

1.24 \$..... is appropriated in fiscal year 2023 to the legislative auditor to conduct the audit
1.25 required in Minnesota Statutes, section 5B.14."

1.26 Renumber the sections in sequence and correct the internal references

1.27 Amend the title accordingly
