Stakeholder Engagement Goals for META

Collaboration	Create a structure to facilitate a high degree of collaboration in implementing META, without being overly burdensome
Statewide Perspective	Employ a statewide perspective, balancing the needs of various stakeholders, including gas and electric utilities, urban and rural constituencies, and residential, business and industrial end-use customers
Broad Engagement	Engage a diverse range of stakeholders, while recognizing that some will have a greater interest in certain aspects of META implementation
Good Governance	Promote transparency and good governance, while preserving ability to be nimble and respond to the market
