Re: Consideration of the Appointment of John Tuma to the Public Utilities Commission

Dear Chair Senjem and members of the Committee:

Clean Grid Alliance (CGA) appreciates the opportunity to provide support for the confirmation of John Tuma to the Public Utilities Commission (PUC).

CGA is a nonprofit organization headquartered and working in Minnesota, along with eight additional states in the Midwest. CGA's membership consists of wind and solar developers, manufacturers, and nonprofit clean energy advocacy organizations. CGA is well-known for its technical and policy expertise, as well as its ability to bring diverse groups together to advance renewable energy development throughout the region.

CGA fully supports the conformation of John Tuma to serve on the PUC. Commissioner Tuma has a long and pronounced track record of working on energy issues in Minnesota.
