

1.1 Senator moves to amend S.F. No. 4062 as follows:

1.2 Page 4, after line 14, insert:

1.3 "(g) \$250,000 the second year is from the
1.4 environmental fund for a grant to the Red
1.5 River Basin Commission to facilitate
1.6 development of a feasibility assessment of
1.7 adaptive phosphorus management for the Red
1.8 River of the North. This is a onetime
1.9 appropriation and is available until December
1.10 31, 2023."

1.11 Correct the subdivision and section totals and the appropriations by fund

1.12 Page 80, after line 10, insert:

1.13 **"Sec. 78. RED RIVER OF THE NORTH; ADAPTIVE PHOSPHORUS**
1.14 **MANAGEMENT FEASIBILITY ASSESSMENT.**

1.15 Subdivision 1. Assessment contents. The Red River Basin Commission must facilitate
1.16 the development of a feasibility assessment of adaptive phosphorus management for the
1.17 Red River of the North. The commission may contract with outside experts or academic
1.18 institutions in developing the assessment. The assessment:

- 1.19 (1) must address applicable water quality targets for phosphorous loading;
- 1.20 (2) must include an allocation of phosphorus between point and nonpoint sources;
- 1.21 (3) must identify cost-effective nutrient reduction implementation strategies; and
- 1.22 (4) may include other state water quality goals and objectives.

1.23 Subd. 2. Advisory group. In developing the assessment, the Red River Basin Commission
1.24 shall work in cooperation with an advisory group consisting of representatives from the
1.25 Minnesota Agricultural Water Resources Center, the Red River Watershed Management
1.26 Board, other agricultural groups, soil and water conservation districts, watershed districts,
1.27 cities, and other Minnesota organizations represented on the board of directors of the Red
1.28 River Basin Commission. The Red River Basin Commission may also work with
1.29 representatives from similar organizations from North Dakota, South Dakota, and Manitoba.

1.30 Subd. 3. Reporting. By June 30, 2024, the Red River Basin Commission must submit
1.31 the final assessment to the chairs and ranking minority members of the house of
1.32 representatives and senate committees with jurisdiction over agriculture policy and finance.

- 2.1 By December 31 of each year prior to the submission of the final assessment, the commission
- 2.2 must submit a progress report on the assessment's development to these same recipients."
- 2.3 Renumber the sections in sequence and correct the internal references
- 2.4 Amend the title accordingly
