


1.1 **Senator Rosen from the Committee on Finance, to which was re-referred**

1.2 **S.F. No. 4025:** A bill for an act relating to opioids; providing for the deposit and
1.3 allocation of opioid settlement proceeds; establishing two accounts in the opiate epidemic
1.4 response fund; eliminating a separate opioid account in the state treasury; modifying the
1.5 time frame for eliminating the opioid manufacturer registration fee and reducing license
1.6 fees; barring municipal claims against litigants in certain settled opioid cases; amending
1.7 Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 256.043, subdivision 1, by adding a subdivision; Minnesota
1.8 Statutes 2021 Supplement, sections 16A.151, subdivision 2; 151.066, subdivision 3; 256.042,
1.9 subdivision 4; 256.043, subdivisions 3, 4; Laws 2019, chapter 63, article 3, section 1, as
1.10 amended; Laws 2021, First Special Session chapter 7, article 16, section 12; proposing
1.11 coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 3.

1.12 Reports the same back with the recommendation that the bill do pass. Report adopted.
