

1.1 Senator moves to amend S.F. No. 4269 as follows:

1.2 Page 30, after line 27, insert:

1.3 "Sec. 29. **ELECTRIC VEHICLE INFRASTRUCTURE DEPLOYMENT PLAN.**

1.4 The commissioner of commerce must create an electric vehicle infrastructure deployment
1.5 plan for state use of funding from the National Electric Vehicle Infrastructure Formula
1.6 Program under the federal Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act. The plan must take a
1.7 holistic approach and consider the future electric charging infrastructure needs of school
1.8 systems, public transportation, counties and municipalities, and other public and private
1.9 users throughout the state. The commissioner must submit this plan to the chairs and ranking
1.10 minority members of the legislative committees having jurisdiction over transportation by
1.11 December 1, 2022.

1.12 Sec. 30. **ACCESSIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR INSTALLATION OF**
1.13 **ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING STATIONS.**

1.14 Until the State Building Code is amended to include accessibility requirements for
1.15 installation of electric vehicle charging stations, any electric vehicle charging station installed
1.16 in this state must meet the accessibility requirements published in the Minnesota Pollution
1.17 Control Agency's "Installation Requirements for Electric Vehicle Charging Stations" guidance
1.18 dated January 2021, or any updates to that document; or for state installations and fleet
1.19 purchases and activities, the Minnesota Department of Transportation's "Guidance: Use,
1.20 Site Design, and Operations of Electric Vehicle (EV) Chargers at MnDOT Facilities" dated
1.21 February 10, 2021, or any updates to that document.

1.22 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section expires the day following adoption of accessibility
1.23 requirements for installation of electric vehicle charging stations in the State Building Code."

1.24 Page 31, after line 25, insert:

1.25 "Subd. 6. **Electric vehicle infrastructure deployment.** \$20,000,000 in fiscal year 2023
1.26 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner of commerce for electric vehicle
1.27 infrastructure deployment and may be used to: (1) meet match requirements for federal
1.28 funds provided to the state by the United States Department of Energy or other federal
1.29 entity; or (2) leverage federal formula and competitive funds for energy-related electric
1.30 vehicle infrastructure deployment investments throughout Minnesota. This is a onetime
1.31 appropriation and is available until June 30, 2034."
