

1.1 **Senator Rosen from the Committee on Finance, to which was re-referred**

1.2 **S.F. No. 4113:** A bill for an act relating to education finance; promoting literacy;
1.3 providing for a statewide reading proficiency goal; requiring access to menstrual products
1.4 in schools; providing for operating capital revenue to fund school district purchases of
1.5 menstrual products; reorganizing the regional centers of excellence; requiring elementary
1.6 education teacher candidates to receive instruction in the Language Essentials for Teachers
1.7 of Reading and Spelling program; requiring a report; appropriating money; amending
1.8 Minnesota Statutes 2020, sections 120B.11, by adding a subdivision; 120B.115; 120B.122,
1.9 by adding a subdivision; 121A.21; 122A.06, subdivision 4; 122A.092, subdivision 5;
1.10 124E.03, subdivision 2; 126C.10, subdivisions 13, 13a, 14; Laws 2021, First Special Session
1.11 chapter 13, article 11, section 4; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter
1.12 120B.

1.13 Reports the same back with the recommendation that the bill be amended as follows:

1.14 Page 5, delete section 5

1.15 Page 9, delete sections 9, 10, and 11

1.16 Page 13, line 8, after "teachers" insert ", priority will be given to those"

1.17 Page 13, line 12, after the period, insert "For teachers who have enrolled but not yet
1.18 completed LETRS training as of June 30, 2025, funds may be encumbered and expended
1.19 until June 30, 2027, for those teachers to complete LETRS training."

1.20 Page 13, delete section 14

1.21 Renumber the sections in sequence

1.22 Amend the title as follows:


1.23 Page 1, line 3, delete everything after the first semicolon

1.24 Page 1, delete line 4

1.25 Page 1, line 7, delete "requiring a report;"

1.26 Amend the title numbers accordingly

1.27 And when so amended the bill do pass. Amendments adopted. Report adopted.
