1.5 Subd. 6. **988; National Suicide Prevention Lifeline number.** The National Suicide
1.6 Prevention Lifeline is expanded to improve the quality of care and access to behavioral
1.7 health crisis services and to further health equity and save lives.

1.8 Sec. 6. Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 145.56, is amended by adding a subdivision to
1.9 read:

1.10 Subd. 7. **Definitions.** (a) For the purposes of this section, the following terms have the
1.11 meanings given.

1.12 (b) "National Suicide Prevention Lifeline" means a national network of certified local
1.13 crisis centers maintained by the Federal Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services
1.14 Administration that provides free and confidential emotional support to people in suicidal
1.15 crisis or emotional distress 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

1.16 (c) "988 Hotline" or "Lifeline Center" means a state identified center that is a member
1.17 of the National Suicide Prevention Lifeline network that responds to statewide or regional
1.18 988 contacts.

1.19 (d) "988 administrator" means the administrator of the 988 National Suicide Prevention
1.20 Lifeline.

1.21 (e) "Veterans Crisis Line" means the Veterans Crisis Line maintained by the Secretary
1.22 of Veterans Affairs under United States Code, title 38, section 170F(h).

1.23 (f) "Department" means the Department of Health.

1.24 (g) "Commissioner" means the commissioner of health.

1.25 Sec. 7. Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 145.56, is amended by adding a subdivision to
1.26 read:

1.27 Subd. 8. **988 National Suicide Prevention Lifeline.** (a) The commissioner of health
1.28 shall administer the designated lifeline and oversee a Lifeline Center or a network of Lifeline
1.29 Centers to answer contacts from individuals accessing the National Suicide Prevention
1.30 Lifeline 24 hours per day, seven days per week.

- 2.1 (b) The designated Lifeline Center(s) shall:
- 2.2 (1) have an active agreement with the administrator of the 988 National Suicide
- 2.3 Prevention Lifeline for participation within the network;
- 2.4 (2) meet the 988 administrator requirements and best practice guidelines for operational
- 2.5 and clinical standards;
- 2.6 (3) provide data, report, and participate in evaluations and related quality improvement
- 2.7 activities as required by the 988 administrator and the department;
- 2.8 (4) use technology that is interoperable across crisis and emergency response systems
- 2.9 used in the state, such as 911 systems, emergency medical services, and the National Suicide
- 2.10 Prevention Lifeline;
- 2.11 (5) deploy crisis and outgoing services, including mobile crisis teams in accordance with
- 2.12 guidelines established by the 988 administrator and the department;
- 2.13 (6) actively collaborate with local mobile crisis teams to coordinate linkages for persons
- 2.14 contacting the 988 Hotline for ongoing care needs;
- 2.15 (7) offer follow-up services to individuals accessing the Lifeline Center that are consistent
- 2.16 with guidance established by the 988 administrator and the department; and
- 2.17 (8) meet the requirements set by the 988 administrator and the department for serving
- 2.18 high risk and specialized populations.
- 2.19 (c) The department shall collaborate with the National Suicide Prevention Lifeline and
- 2.20 Veterans Crisis Line networks for the purpose of ensuring consistency of public messaging
- 2.21 about 988 services."

2.22 Page 25, after line 5, insert:

2.23 "Sec. 33. **APPROPRIATION; 988 NATIONAL SUICIDE PREVENTION LIFELINE.**

2.24 \$8,671,000 is appropriated in fiscal year 2023 from the general fund to the commissioner

2.25 of health for the 988 suicide prevention lifeline in Minnesota Statutes, section 145.56. The

2.26 general fund base for this appropriation is \$10,019,000 in fiscal year 2024 and \$10,019,000

2.27 in fiscal year 2025."
