Senator Julie A. Rosen called the meeting to order at 8:34 A.M. on May 4, 2022 in Room 1200 of the Minnesota Senate Building. A quorum was present.

**S.F. 4209: Senator Housley: Office of the Foster Youth Ombudsperson and Board of the Foster Youth Ombudsperson establishment and appropriation.**

Senator Ingebrigtsen moved the A6 Amendment.

Senator Housley spoke to the A6 Amendment.

Senator Ingebrigtsen renewed the motion to adopt the A6 Amendment. On a voice vote, the motion prevailed and THE A6 AMENDMENT WAS ADOPTED.

Senator Housley spoke to SF 4209, as amended.

Hoang Murphy, Executive Director, Foster Advocates, testified.

Senator Ingebrigtsen moved that S.F. 4209, as amended, be recommended to pass. - **MOTION PREVAILED.**

Senator Ingebrihtsen moved that H.F. 3438, as amended, be recommended to pass. - MOTION PREVAILED.


