

- 1.1 Senator moves to amend S.F. No. 3008 as follows:
- 1.2 Delete everything after the enacting clause and insert:
- 1.3 "Section 1. **ADVISORY TAX FORCE; COLEMAN ACT.**
- 1.4 (a) The commissioner of public safety must convene an advisory task force to advise
- 1.5 the commissioner regarding potential market, regulatory, and legal consequences associated
- 1.6 with the proposed legislative changes to the Coleman Act, Minnesota Statutes, section
- 1.7 340A.307, embodied in S.F. No. 3008 and H.F. No. 2767, introduced during the 2022
- 1.8 legislative session.
- 1.9 (b) The task force must include:
- 1.10 (i) a representative of licensed alcoholic beverage importers;
- 1.11 (ii) a representative of licensed alcoholic beverage wholesalers;
- 1.12 (iii) a representative of licensed alcoholic beverage manufacturers;
- 1.13 (iv) a representative of the Minnesota Licensed Beverage Association;
- 1.14 (v) a Minnesota consumer of alcoholic beverages; and
- 1.15 (vi) other market participants that in the judgment of the commissioner may lend
- 1.16 additional needed expertise and perspective to the task force.
- 1.17 The commissioner must make appointments to the task force by July 1, 2022, and convene
- 1.18 the task force by August 1, 2022.
- 1.19 (c) The commissioner must report by January 15, 2023, to the chairs and ranking minority
- 1.20 members of the legislative committees having jurisdiction over alcoholic beverages on the
- 1.21 issues identified in paragraph (a).
- 1.22 (d) \$25,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner of public safety
- 1.23 in fiscal year 2023 for operations of the task force and preparation of the report."
- 1.24 Amend the title accordingly
