1.1 A bill for an act  
1.2 relating to commerce; modifying a definition applying to licensee education;  
1.3 amending Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 45.25, subdivision 12.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 45.25, subdivision 12, is amended to read:

1.6 Subd. 12. **Proctor.** (a) "Proctor" means a disinterested third party with no conflict of  
1.7 interest person who (1) verifies a student's identity, and (2) processes an affidavit testifying  
1.8 that the student received no outside assistance with the course or examination.

1.9 (b) A proctor must be 18 years of age or older. A proctor must not have a financial or  
1.10 other conflict of interest with respect to a student's successful completion of the course or  
1.11 the examination. A proctor must not be: (1) a friend or relative of the student; (2) the student's  
1.12 supervisor at work; (3) a person the student supervises at work; or (4) a student who is  
1.13 completing the same course.
