| 1.7 | Subdivision 1. Safe schools revenue. (a) Each district may make a levy on all taxable |
| 1.8 | property located within the district for the purposes specified in this section. The maximum |
| 1.9 | amount which may be levied for all costs under this section shall be equal to \$36 multiplied |
| 1.10 | by the district's adjusted pupil units for the school year. For fiscal year 2023, a district's safe |
| 1.11 | schools revenue equals the greater of \$44 times the district's adjusted pupil units for the |
| 1.12 | school year or \$22,000. For fiscal year 2024 and later, a district's safe schools revenue equals |

(4) to pay the costs for security in the district's schools and on school property;

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3.1 (5) to pay the costs for other crime prevention, drug abuse, student and staff safety,
3.2 voluntary opt-in suicide prevention tools, and violence prevention measures taken by the
3.3 school district;

3.4 (6) to pay costs for licensed school counselors, licensed school nurses, licensed school
3.5 social workers, licensed school psychologists, and licensed alcohol and chemical dependency
3.6 counselors to help provide early responses to problems;

3.7 (7) to pay for facility security enhancements including laminated glass, public
3.8 announcement systems, emergency communications devices, and equipment and facility
3.9 modifications related to violence prevention and facility security;

3.10 (8) to pay for costs associated with improving the school climate; or

- 3.11 (9) to pay costs for colocating and collaborating with mental health professionals who
 3.12 are not district employees or contractors or for school-linked mental health services delivered
 3.13 by telemedicine; or

3.14 (10) to pay for the costs of enhancing cybersecurity in the district's information systems.

(b) For expenditures under paragraph (a), clause (1), the district must initially attempt
to contract for services to be provided by peace officers or sheriffs with the police department
of each city or the sheriff's department of the county within the district containing the school
receiving the services. If a local police department or a county sheriff's department does
not wish to provide the necessary services, the district may contract for these services with
any other police or sheriff's department located entirely or partially within the school district's
boundaries.

3.22 (c) A school district that is a member of an intermediate school district may include in
3.23 its authority under this section the costs associated with safe schools activities authorized
3.24 under paragraph (a) for intermediate school district programs. This authority must not exceed
3.25 \$15 times the adjusted pupil units of the member districts. This authority is in addition to
3.26 any other authority authorized under this section. Revenue raised under this paragraph must
3.27 be transferred to the intermediate school district.
