

1.1 Senator moves to amend the delete-everything amendment (SCS4113A-1)
1.2 to S.F. No. 4113 as follows:

1.3 Page 6, after line 28, insert:

1.4 "Sec. 7. [124D.421] MINNESOTA TUTORING CORPS.

1.5 (a) By September 1, 2022, the commissioner of education must establish a Minnesota
1.6 tutoring corps program to provide additional instructional support to elementary, middle,
1.7 and high school students who have experienced learning loss as a result of the COVID-19
1.8 pandemic. The program must offer instructional support in all required subject areas under
1.9 section 120B.021, subdivision 1.

1.10 (b) A tutor must be:

1.11 (1) enrolled in a course under section 124D.09, subdivision 10, paragraph (b);

1.12 (2) enrolled in a bachelor's degree program related to education; or

1.13 (3) a graduate within the last three years of a board-approved teacher preparation program
1.14 under section 122A.092.

1.15 To the extent funds are available, the commissioner may provide stipends to tutors.

1.16 (c) The commissioner may partner with an organization or an approved teacher
1.17 preparation program to implement the program.

1.18 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment."

1.19 Page 9, after line 17, insert:

1.20 "Subd. 3. **Minnesota tutoring corps stipends.** (a) For providing stipends to the tutoring
1.21 corps under Minnesota Statutes, section 124D.421:

1.22 § 2,500,000 2023

1.23 (b) The base for fiscal year 2024 and later is \$2,500,000.

1.24 (c) The department may retain up to three percent of the appropriation amount in each
1.25 year to monitor and administer the program.

1.26 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** Subdivision 3 is effective the day following final enactment."

1.27 Renumber the sections in sequence and correct the internal references

1.28 Amend the title accordingly
