S.F. No. 3258 – Modifications to the Board of Medical Practice statutes (with A-1 amendment)

S.F. 3258 makes minor modifications to the licensure requirements under the jurisdiction of the Board of Medical Practice.

Section 1 (147.03, subdivision 1) makes technical modifications to the examination requirements for licensure to practice medicine by reciprocity. Adds the comprehensive osteopathic medical licensing examination as an examination option.

Section 2 (147.037, subd. 1) makes technical modifications to the licensure requirements that apply to applicants who are foreign medical school graduates. Adds the comprehensive osteopathic medical licensing examination as an examination option.

Section 3 (147.141) makes technical changes.

Section 4 (147A.16) makes a technical change

Section 5 (147B.02, subd. 7) removes the requirement for an acupuncture license that the applicant must submit a notarized copy of a current NCCAOM certification, and only requires the applicant to submit evidence that is satisfactory to the board on current NCCAOM certification.

Section 6 repeals several rules relating to professional corporations providing certain information to the board.
