1.3 S.F. No. 3566: A bill for an act relating to health care; modifying the definition of
1.4 intractable pain; modifying the criteria for prescribing controlled substance for the treatment
1.5 of intractable pain; amending Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 152.125.

1.6 Reports the same back with the recommendation that the bill be amended as follows:

1.7 Page 1, delete lines 10 and 11 and insert:

1.8 "(b) "Drug diversion" means the unlawful transfer of prescription drugs from their licit
1.9 medical purpose to the illicit marketplace."

1.10 Page 1, line 21, after "physician" insert ", advanced practice registered nurse, or physician

1.11 assistant" and after "physicians" insert ", advanced practice registered nurses, or physician

1.12 assistants"

1.13 Page 2, lines 4 and 5, after "physician" insert ", advanced practice registered nurse, or

1.14 physician assistant"

1.15 Page 2, delete lines 7 to 10 and insert:

1.16 "(d) "Palliative care" has the meaning provided in section 144A.75, subdivision 12."

1.17 Page 2, delete line 16 and insert "(1) a diagnosis of intractable pain by the treating

1.18 physician, advanced practice registered nurse, or physician assistant and either by a physician,

1.19 advanced practice registered nurse, or physician assistant "

1.20 Page 2, line 17, after "physician" insert ", advanced practice registered nurse, or physician
1.21 assistant"

1.22 Page 3, line 17, before "opioid" insert "limited to"

1.23 Page 4, line 2, after "physician" insert a comma and delete "or"

1.24 Page 4, line 3, after "nurse" insert ", or physician assistant"


1.25 Page 4, line 21, after "must" insert "mutually agree to the treatment and"

1.26 Page 4, line 22, after "the" insert "prescriber's and the"

1.27 And when so amended the bill do pass and be re-referred to the Committee on Civil
