Bill Description

Section 1 amends an existing dental utilization report starting in March 15, 2023 to include information about dental services in Minnesota Health Care Programs (MHCP) as specified.

Assumptions

Data analysts at the Department of Human Services (DHS) can use provider enrollment and claims and encounter data to provide most of the information included in the bill language; for the number of dentists enrolled by county, DHS will estimate counties served using residence of the enrollee as of their last enrollment. The annual study was established in the 2021 First Special Session and an appropriation was already provided to complete the ongoing work. It is assumed that the changes in this bill merely provide more specificity in how this work will be completed and do not require an additional appropriation.
