

1.1 Senator moves to amend S.F. No. 3249 as follows:

1.2 Page 18, after line 28, insert:

1.3 "Sec. 13. HEALTH CARE PROFESSIONAL WELL-BEING EDUCATION AND
1.4 OUTREACH INITIATIVE.

1.5 The commissioner of health, in coordination with a work group comprised of health
1.6 care professionals, health care systems, health plan organizations, health professional
1.7 associations, and mental health experts who focus on provider burnout, shall:

1.8 (1) develop and implement an education and awareness initiative that:

1.9 (i) describes the symptoms and risk factors for professional burnout and moral injury;

1.10 (ii) addresses the stigma among health care professionals associated with seeking
1.11 self-care, including mental health and substance use disorder services;

1.12 (iii) encourages health care professionals to seek support and care for their mental health
1.13 and substance use disorder concerns; and

1.14 (iv) helps health care professionals identify risk factors associated with suicide and other
1.15 mental health conditions;

1.16 (2) develop and make available educational resources to support health care professionals
1.17 with self-care and resiliency;

1.18 (3) establish priorities for health care organizations to take to prevent and reduce health
1.19 care professional burnout and moral injury; and

1.20 (4) develop evidence-based measurable outcomes to determine the effectiveness of
1.21 strategies taken by health care organizations to prevent and reduce health care professional
1.22 burnout and moral injury."

1.23 Page 20, after line 21, insert:

1.24 "Sec. 23. APPROPRIATION.

1.25 \$1,000,000 in fiscal year 2023 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner
1.26 of health to implement the health care professional well-being education and outreach
1.27 initiative. This is a onetime appropriation."

1.28 Renumber the sections in sequence and correct the internal references
