1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. **APPROPRIATION; HOPE 4 YOUTH.**

1.6 \$..... in fiscal year 2023 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner of

1.7 human services for a grant to HOPE 4 Youth, a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization, to acquire

1.8 property, predesign, design, construct, furnish, and equip a youth homeless drop-in center

1.9 in Anoka County. This appropriation is available until the project is completed or abandoned

1.10 subject to Minnesota Statutes, section 16A.642.

1.11 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
