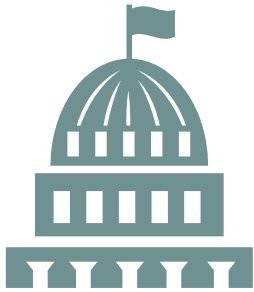




# Enhanced Treatment Program (ETP) Funding



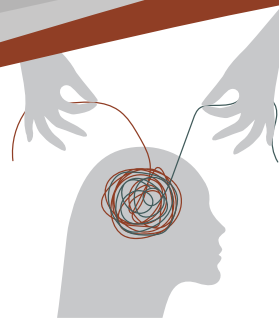
## PROBLEM

The Minnesota Department of Human Services ceased funding support to this award-winning program designed to stop the cycle of relapse.

## SOLUTION

Restore DHS funding support to help women:

- remain sober.
- regain custody of minor children.
- achieve permanent housing.
- keep stable employment.
- avoid new criminal convictions.



## ? What is ETP

The Enhanced Treatment Program provides rehabilitative services to mothers struggling with substance abuse, who are involved in the court system and at risk of permanently losing custody of their children.

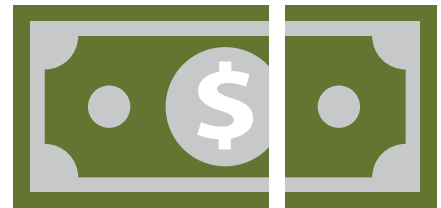


**86%** have maintained custody of their children 5 years after graduation.

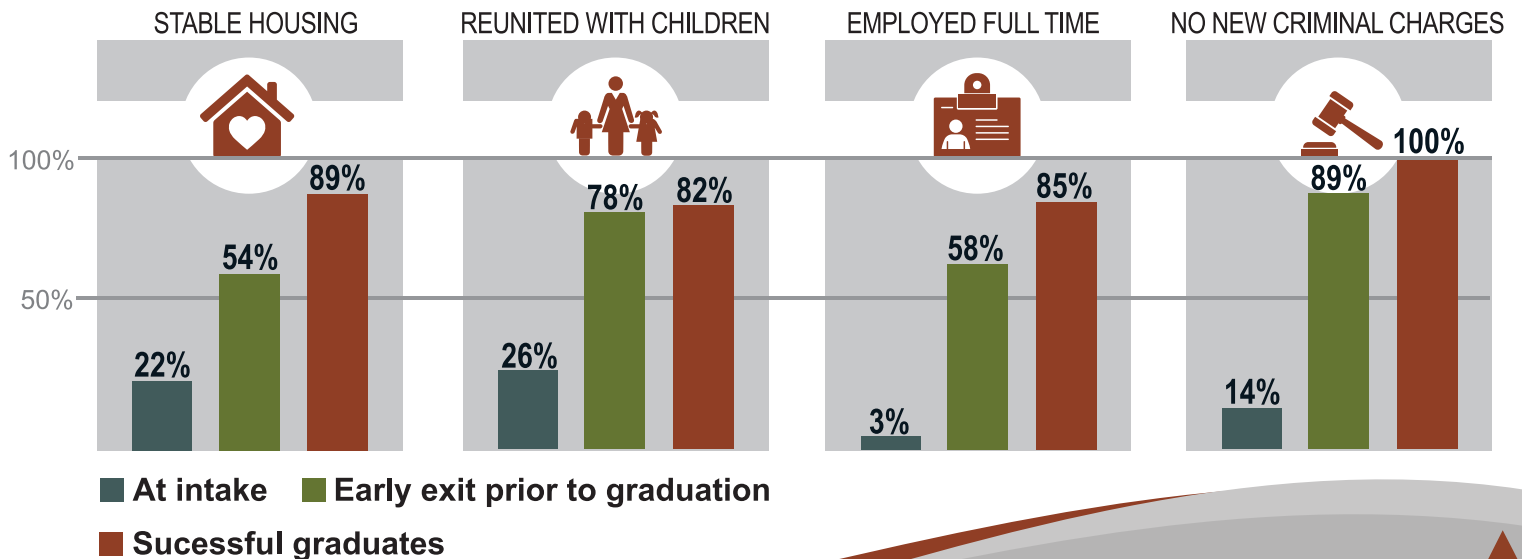
