

1.1 Senator moves to amend the delete-everything amendment (SCS4410A-1)
1.2 to S.F. No. 4410 as follows:

1.3 Page 73, after line 21, insert:

1.4 "Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 245C.02, subdivision 17a, is amended to
1.5 read:

1.6 Subd. 17a. **Roster.** (a) "Roster" means the electronic method used to identify the entity
1.7 or entities required to conduct background studies under this chapter with which a background
1.8 subject is affiliated. There are three types of rosters: active roster, inactive roster, and master
1.9 roster.

1.10 (b) "Active roster" means the list of individuals specific to an entity who have been
1.11 determined eligible under this chapter to provide services for the entity and who the entity
1.12 has identified as affiliated. An individual shall remain on the entity's active roster and is
1.13 considered affiliated until the commissioner determines the individual is ineligible or the
1.14 entity removes the individual from the entity's active roster.

1.15 (c) "Inactive roster" means the list maintained by the commissioner of individuals who
1.16 are eligible under this chapter to provide services and are not on an active roster. Individuals
1.17 shall remain on the inactive roster for no more than 180 consecutive days, unless:

1.18 (1) the individual submits a written request to the commissioner requesting to remain
1.19 on the inactive roster for a longer period of time; or

1.20 (2) the individual self-initiated a background study, in which case the individual shall
1.21 remain on the inactive roster for one year.

1.22 Upon the commissioner's receipt of information that may cause an individual on the inactive
1.23 roster to be disqualified under this chapter, the commissioner shall remove the individual
1.24 from the inactive roster, and if the individual again seeks a position requiring a background
1.25 study, the individual shall be required to complete a new background study.

1.26 (d) "Master roster" means the list maintained by the commissioner of all individuals
1.27 who, as a result of a background study under this chapter, and regardless of affiliation with
1.28 an entity, are determined by the commissioner to be eligible to provide services for one or
1.29 more entities. The master roster includes all background study subjects on rosters under
1.30 paragraphs (b) and (c).

2.1 Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 2021 Supplement, section 245C.03, is amended by adding a
2.2 subdivision to read:

2.3 Subd. 16. **Self-initiated background studies.** The commissioner shall conduct
2.4 background studies according to this chapter when initiated by an individual who is not on
2.5 the master roster. A subject under this subdivision who is not disqualified must be placed
2.6 on the inactive roster.

2.7 Sec. 3. Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 245C.04, is amended by adding a subdivision to
2.8 read:

2.9 Subd. 12. **Individuals.** An individual who initiates a background study under section
2.10 245C.03, subdivision 22, must initiate the studies annually through NETStudy 2.0.

2.11 Sec. 4. Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 245C.10, is amended by adding a subdivision to
2.12 read:

2.13 Subd. 22. **Individuals.** The commissioner shall recover the cost of the background
2.14 studies initiated by individuals under section 245C.03, subdivision 16, through a fee of no
2.15 more than \$42 per study charged to the individual. The fees collected under this subdivision
2.16 are appropriated to the commissioner for the purpose of conducting background studies."
