Senator Rarick, Vice-Chair, called the meeting to order at 1:05 p.m. A quorum was present.

S.F. 3818: Senator Coleman: Youth skill path program establishment for employment-based training.

Senator Julia Coleman, chief author of S.F. 3818, explained the bill as follows (see bill summary and bill):

A bill for an act relating to education; establishing a youth skill path program for employment-based training; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 124D.

Senator Rarick moved the author's amendment (see amendment #SCS3818A-1). The **MOTION PREVAILED** and the **AMENDMENT WAS ADOPTED**.

S.F. 3001: Senator Putnam: Higher education state grant program parameters modification.

Senator Putnam, chief author of S.F. 3001, explained the bill as follows (see bill summary and bill):

A bill for an act relating to higher education; modifying parameters in the state grant program; modifying restrictions on developmental education in state colleges and universities; creating new grant programs within the Office of Higher Education; requiring reports; appropriating money; amending Minnesota Statutes 2020, sections 136A.121, subdivision 5; 136F.302, subdivisions 1, 2; Minnesota Statutes 2021 Supplement, section 136A.121, subdivisions 6, 9.

Senator Putnam moved to amend S.F. 3001 (see amendment #SCS3001A-2). The **MOTION PREVAILED** and the **AMENDMENT WAS ADOPTED**.
