1.19 ~~for eight semesters or the equivalent~~ has previously received state grant funds for a period
1.20 of ten semesters or the equivalent, excluding (1) courses taken from a Minnesota school or
1.21 postsecondary institution which is not participating in the state grant program and from
1.22 which a student transferred no credit, and (2) courses taken that qualify as developmental
1.23 education or below college-level. A student enrolled in a two-year program at a four-year
