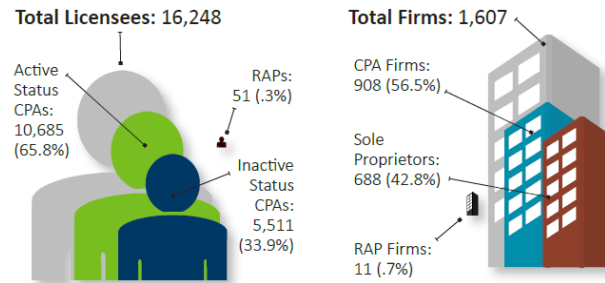
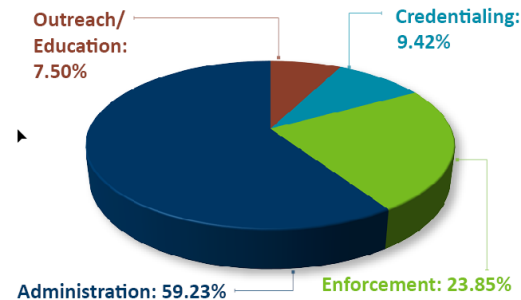

REQUEST:

Funding for one (1) additional FTE State Program Administrative (SPA) dedicated to licensing.
(\$120k per annum)

RATIONALE/BACKGROUND:

- Board meeting current service standards through interagency agreements; other agency reducing those agreements to meet its own service standards.
- Board needs individual dedicated to oversight, improvements, innovations, and training in licensing area, ensuring procedures, rules, and statutes are followed and procedures updated and current technologies utilized.
- Addition frees an existing SPA position split between licensing and enforcement to be dedicated to enforcement.

Better service to the public in all key areas: licensure, enforcement and public protection.
