

S.F. No. 2862 – Electronic pull-tab devices, games, and systems not subject to changes in rule unless authorized by the legislature

Section 1 [Minn. Stat. sec. 349.151, subd. 4d; Electronic pull-tab devices and electronic pull-tab game system] prohibits the Gambling Control Board from deactivating or prohibiting electronic pull-tab devices, games, or game systems that had been approved by the board under rules at the time of the approval, unless the legislature, by law, requires the devices, games, or game systems to comply with later-adopted rules.

Section 2 [Minn. Stat. sec. 349.1721, subd. 1; Cumulative or carryover games] makes electronic pull-tab games exempt from rules regarding cumulative or carryover prizes that are adopted after the game was approved, unless the legislature, by law, requires the electronic pull-tab game to comply with later-adopted rules.

Section 3 [Minn. Stat. sec. 349.1721, subd. 2; Event games] makes electronic pull-tab games exempt from rules relating to selection of winner by random selection that are adopted after the game was approved, unless the legislature, by law, requires the electronic pull-tab game to comply with later-adopted rules.
