Bill Description

The Bill repeals the sunset date of the Advisory Committee for Capitol Area Security (ACCAS) as established in Minnesota Statutes 299E.04, subdivision 5. ACCAS was formed in 2012 and the sunset is scheduled to take place on June 30th 2022.

Assumptions

The meeting frequency and nature of the business that ACCAS conducts does not change.

Meetings will be held approximately four (4) times each year. The Facilities Management Director will spend approximately 12 hours for each meeting preparing materials, attending meetings, and completing follow up assignments.

These salary costs will continue to be absorbed within the division's Lease budget. The costs are allocated across 3 million square feet in buildings under the custodial control or management of Facilities Management.

Facilities Management Director Salary and Fringe costs

4 meetings per year * 12 hours per meeting * \$80.39 salary and fringe rate = \$3859 annually
