**Section 5 [155A.27, subd. 1; Licensing]** requires a person to have a license issued by the board of cosmetologist examiners to practice as a hair technician. **Section 1 [155A.23; Hair technician]** defines “hair technician.”

**Section 11 [Appropriation]** appropriates money from the general fund to the board of cosmetologist examiners for implementing licensing for hair technicians.

The remaining sections are conforming changes to treat hair technician licensees similarly to other practitioners licensed by the board of cosmetologist examiners.
