

1.1 Senator moves to amend S.F. No. 4045 as follows:

1.2 Page 1, line 18, delete "and" and insert ". Except for initial members, members"

1.3 Page 1, line 19, strike "and" and insert a period and after "legislature" insert "are"

1.4 Page 1, line 22, delete "15.059" and insert "15.0597"

1.5 Page 2, line 26, after the period, insert "Members appointed under this paragraph serve
1.6 until their successors are appointed."

1.7 Page 2, line 31, delete "Notwithstanding section 15.059,"

1.8 Page 3, line 2, strike everything after "(b)"

1.9 Page 3, line 3, strike "chairperson"

1.10 Page 3, after line 6, insert:

1.11 "(g) Members may be removed as provided in section 15.059, subdivision 4.

1.12 (h) Public members serve without compensation, but may have expenses reimbursed as
1.13 provided in Minnesota Statutes, section 15.059, subdivision 3. Legislative members may
1.14 receive per diem according to the rules of their respective bodies."

1.15 Page 4, after line 24, insert:

1.16 "(c) Legislative members may not deliberate about or vote on decisions related to the
1.17 issuance of grants of state money."

1.18 Page 4, after line 33, insert:

1.19 "Sec. 2. **INITIAL MEMBERS; MINNESOTA RARE DISEASE ADVISORY**
1.20 **COUNCIL.**

1.21 Public members serving on the University of Minnesota's Advisory Council on Rare
1.22 Diseases on June 30, 2022, are the initial public members of the Minnesota Rare Disease
1.23 Advisory Council. The terms of the members begins on July 1, 2022. The governor must
1.24 designate six members to serve a two-year term; six members to serve a three-year term;
1.25 and five members to serve a four-year term. The governor may appoint additional members
1.26 under Minnesota Statutes, section 137.68, subdivision 2, paragraph (b), clause (13), and
1.27 must set their terms so that roughly one-third of the members terms expire after two years,
1.28 one-third after three years, and one-third after four years. Legislative members of the
1.29 University of Minnesota's Advisory Council on Rare Disease serve on the Minnesota Rare
1.30 Disease Advisory Council until appointing authorities appoint successors."
