

S.F. No. 700 – Impounded Vehicle Charges

Section 1. Towed motor vehicles. Amends the types of charges subject to a lien when a person tows and stores a motor vehicle at the request of a law enforcement officer. Under current law, costs for storage and towing are subject to a lien. Under this bill, charges for recovery of the vehicle and cargo, storage of the vehicle and cargo, and accident site cleanup are subject to a lien. The person who tows the vehicle may retain the vehicle and its cargo, except that the owner may retrieve contents as provided by current law.

Section 2. Payment of charges. Makes changes to the law regarding paying towing charges to reference the same charges listed in **section 1**.
