1.5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
1.6	Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 171.07, subdivision 15, is amended to read:
1.7	Subd. 15. Veteran designation. (a) At the request of an eligible applicant and on payment
1.8	of the required fee, the department shall issue, renew, or reissue to the applicant a driver's
1.9	license or Minnesota identification card bearing a graphic or written designation of:
1.10	(1) Veteran; or
1.11	(2) Veteran 100% T&P.
1.12	(b) At the time of the initial application for the designation provided under this
1.13	subdivision, the applicant must:
1.14	(1) be either:
1.15	(i) a veteran, as defined in section 197.447; or
1.16	(ii) a retired member of the National Guard or a reserve component of the United States
1.17	armed forces, who provides documentation demonstrating that the applicant qualifies for
1.18	nonregular retirement or reserve retirement;
1.19	(2) have provide a certified copy of the veteran's applicant's federal form DD-214, form
1.20	NGB-22, or other official release or discharge papers, that confirms an honorable or general
1.21	discharge status; and

- 2.1 (3) if the applicant is seeking the disability designation under paragraph (a), clause (2),
- 2.2 provide satisfactory evidence of a 100 percent total and permanent service-connected
- 2.3 disability as determined by the United States Department of Veterans Affairs.
- 2.4 (c) The commissioner of public safety is required to issue drivers' licenses and Minnesota
- 2.5 identification cards with the veteran designation only after entering a new contract or in
- 2.6 coordination with producing a new card design with modifications made as required by
- 2.7 **law.**
- 2.8 EFFECTIVE DATE; APPLICATION. This section is effective August 1, 2022, and
  2.9 applies to applications submitted on or after that date.
