1.3 **S.F. No. 2875:** A bill for an act relating to drivers' licenses; amending eligibility for a
1.4 veteran designation on drivers' licenses or Minnesota identification cards; amending
1.5 Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 171.07, subdivision 15.

1.6 Reports the same back with the recommendation that the bill be amended as follows:

1.7 Page 1, line 14, delete "either" and insert "one of the following"

1.8 Page 1, line 15, delete "or"

1.9 Page 1, after line 18, insert:

1.10 "(iii) a member of the National Guard or a reserve component of the United States armed
1.11 forces, who provides a Veteran Identification Card; or


1.12 (iv) a member of the National Guard or a reserve component of the United States armed
1.13 forces, who provides a Veteran Health Identification Card;"

1.14 Page 1, line 19, delete the comma and insert "or"

1.15 Page 1, line 20, delete ", or other official release or" and strike "discharge papers"

1.16 Page 1, line 21, after "discharge" insert "under honorable conditions"

1.17 And when so amended the bill do pass and be re-referred to the Committee on Veterans
1.18 and Military Affairs Finance and Policy. Amendments adopted. Report adopted.
