Priority Projects to Support 2022 Legislative Request for \$28 Million

St. Paul Port Authority:

- Harbor Improvements to accommodate River Cruises \$2,500,000
- Red Rock New Barge Loading System \$7,500,000

Port of Winona:

- Winona Mississippi Riverfront Connection-Dock Expansion
Rehabilitate Levee 2021-2022 \$2,300,000

Red Wing Port Authority:

- Bulkhead repair and rebuilding \$1,725,000
- Levee dock mooring cluster repair and replacement \$ 440,000
- River channel sediment control measures near bulkhead \$3,000,000

Duluth Seaway Port Authority:

- Demolish four compromised and outdated grain elevator
structures and ancillary building \$ 3,500,000
- Rehabilitate 1,950 lineal feet of dilapidated dock wall \$14,000,000
